Main Barriers typically faced by children following the school closure period:

- Gaps in curriculum knowledge
- Missing strategies to solve problems/complete work
- Lack of stamina
- Lack of independence
- Emotional difficulties
- Friendship difficulties
- Issues with routines
- Lower self-esteem
- Lower confidence
- Lack of wider out of school experiences
- Challenging behaviours
- Lower attendance

Actions to address these barriers; using the catch up premium:

- Supply cover to release class teacher to deliver targeted booster groups.
- HIAS led staff meeting on math catch up curriculum
- Hampshire training on catch up curriculum in all years for Maths and English.
- Mental health and wellbeing Hampshire training.
- Family support hours to target families to support home learning and engagement.
- Greater information shared with parents to support home learning.
- Virtual learning plan to ensure no learning time is lost.
- Extra ELSA sessions made available.
- Meet and greet
- Teaching Assistants to provide additional in class support for reading, writing and maths and within the wider curriculum
- Teaching Assistants to provide additional small group or 1:1 support for reading, writing and maths; time release class teachers to provide high quality catch up teaching
- Additional forest school sessions at lunch time
- Curriculum resources

How the spend will be monitored:

- Pupil Progress meetings with Headteacher and Inclusions Leader working with class teachers and Phase Leaders
- Home/school link worker performance management and half termly reviews
- Senior and Middle leaders making class observations of teaching and learning
- Inclusions Leader making observations of children in class
- Inclusions Leader making observations of interventions being delivered by teachers and teaching assistants
- Pupil conferencing
- Book monitoring
