



Dear Parents and Carers

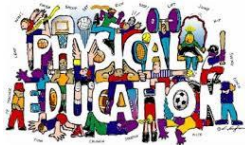
I find it hard to believe that we are already at the end of half term; it feels like yesterday that I was welcoming you all to the start of a new year.
