It was wonderful to hear their experiences and excitement as they joined in with the discussion.



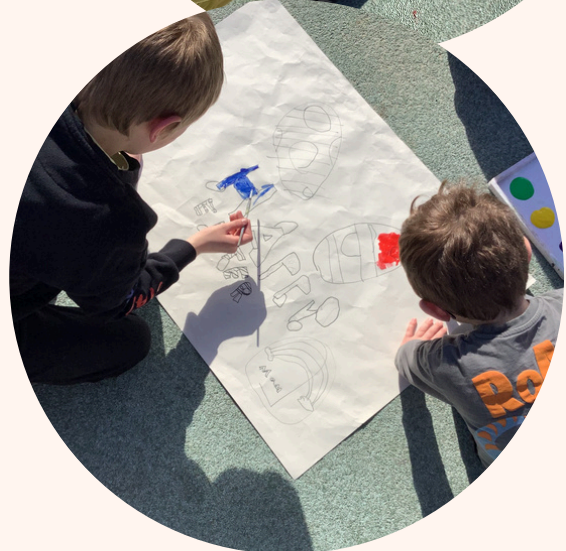
EXPLORE. LEARN AND DISCOVER!
